

Commanders

- Referentie gives the Crew-year of the Officer, for Reserve and War Officers (Kriegsoffiziere) the date of entry (Diensteintritt), abbreviated to "D".
Between brackets stands – where applicable - the RDA (Rangdienstalter) the officer did receive afterwards.
- "RO" stands for Reserve Officer,
"KrO" for War Officer (Kriegsoffizier),
"K-S" for CO Trainee (Kmdt-Schüler),
"KW" for change of CO (with the date given in the war diary)(KW = Kmdt-Wechsel)
"Bbl" for new construction acquaintance (Baubelehrung),
"KLA" for Kriegsschiffbaulehrabteilung and
"plvv voor" stands for "replacement for" (in Vertretung für).
- Commanding Officer (Kommandant),
Construction acquaintance CO (Bbl-Kmdt),
CO trainee (Kmdt-Schüler) and
Replacement CO (Kmdt in Vertretung)
can individually be searched for using the special events (FST) defined for them.
- „**All** Commanding Officers (C/O,acquaintance,replacement,trainee,info)“
can be selected as group-event when every ‚type‘ of Commanding Officer is to figure in the output.

This event can be used in DUIKBOOT, for example, to:
 - generate a list of Commanding Officers;
 - list all CO's (including acquaintance, replacement and trainee CO's) of a specific uboat;
 - list for a single officer the various CO-positions he occupied (on a single boat when a U-number is introduced in the search mask, or for all boats he served on when no U-number is defined).
- First names between ' ' are call names, part of the full first name, or the first name used.
- "D*" in Feit means the date provided is uncertain.
